9.1 Operations – Fire Chief Weber provided an overview of the calls for the month of February 2023 noting that he is submitting a reimbursement request for the Storm Response. The Type III is in service for primer pump. Information has been sent to ESO (the new records management system).

Chief Weber has started a new process for purchases made with the District credit cards noting that receipts will be submitted along with a form that lists the description of the purchase and is signed by the employee.

Chief Weber contacted our current approved vendors to update the approved list of active staff allowed to charge purchases to the accounts.

Administrative Assistant Lorena Coose provided an update on the Budget.

- **9.2** Fire Prevention/Public Education Fire Chief Weber noted that BC Firman is working on updating fire permits and there have been several driveway inspections completed.
