Chief Ramirez noted that the SAFER Grant was not granted to Mokelumne Fire for the three additional contracted staff. This will cause the District to go into the red for the current fiscal year for approximately \$100,000 to \$150,000. The amount at this time is unknown because the District is receiving some income from Strike Teams. The Chief plans to apply for the SAFER Grant again this year and notification of grant awards.

There is an option to lay off the three contract firefighters at this time. The Board directed Chief Ramirez to monitor the financials closely during this fiscal year and not lay off any firefighters at this time.
